#### TRAVEL INFORMATION

There is free and ample customer parking available, and bus services that link Inverness train station to the climbing centre.

### **FOOD & DRINK**

The café will be open upstairs, serving tea, coffee, cakes, and light meals. There will be a specified break for refuelling when climbing comes to an end. We strongly encourage all competitors to eat and drink something at this point if they have not done so already through the event. Competitors are welcome to bring in their own sports snacks and drinks, but it has been requested that all people attending make use of the café facilities available and do not bring in meals of picnics. Please do not eat or drink on the matting and avoid spillages and leaving litter around.

### **COMPETITION ZONES**

An area is dedicated as a Competition Zone for the safety of competitors. Please note, that only competitors, judges and ClimbScotland Officials are allowed in the competition zone. At the Ledge all matted areas will be Competition Zones. **PLEASE DO NOT SIT ON THE EDGES OF THE MATS**. ClimbScotland CCOs and Marshalls will ask you to move.

### **BAGS AND KIT**

To help keep spaces clear for competitors, staff and spectators we ask that all kit is stored in the available changing spaces, or under the benches throughout the centre or the changing rooms. You will also be permitted to store bags upstairs on the matting where the training boards are.





#### CLIMBING AT THE VENUE AFTER THE COMPETITION

If anyone wishes to climb after the competition has finished, they **must** follow The Ledge's standard entry procedure, and they **must** report to the centre's reception desk.

Climbing during the competition (other than by competitors as part of the competition) is stickly prohibited, and even if the competition climbing has finished you will not be allowed to climb until after the presentations have been held, and the event has finished.
