Dundee's first gym dedicated solely to bouldering. A state-of-the-art facility offering over 100 boulder problems suitable for both beginner and experienced climbers.

#### TRAVEL INFORMATION

There is free on street parking on the roads around the climbing centre. However, it is important to note that there will be a football game on in the stadium nearby, which means there will be parking restrictions between 15:00 & 17:00 on the road outside and immediately around the centre. Please see the map included in the information email for further details on where is affected.

Bus transport is available from the city centre of Dundee, and we can be accessed via the number 1, 22 or 17 bus routes.

#### FOOD & DRINK

There will be hot and cold drinks available at the wall reception desk. They also have some snacks and will have a limited number of small meals. You may wish to bring packed lunch. Competitors should be careful to maintain hydration, but do not leave bottles on the matting.

#### COMPETITION ZONES

An area is dedicated as a Competition Zone for the safety of competitors. Please note, that only competitors, judges and ClimbScotland Officials are allowed in the competition zone. At Block 10 all matted areas will be Competition Zones. **PLEASE DO NOT SIT ON THE EDGES OF THE MATS.** ClimbScotland CCOs and Marshalls will ask you to move.

#### BAGS AND KIT

As there is limited floor space for spectators, all rucksacks and non-climbing kit should be left in the room indicated on the map. Please don't clutter the spectator area.

**CLIMBING AT THE VENUE AFTER THE COMPETITION**

If anyone wishes to climb after the competition has finished, they **must** follow Block 10's standard entry procedure, and they **must** report to the centre's reception desk.

Climbing during the competition (other than by competitors as part of the competition) is stickly prohibited. Once the climbing has finished, and results are being calculated, you may climb, but **ONLY** if you have gone through Block 10's standard entry procedure. This will involve ensuring you are appropriately registered and have gone to the reception desk and paid for entry to the wall.
